

## **Expression of Interest**

## VIDEOGRAPHER

The City of Albany Arts and Culture team have been successful in receiving funding from the Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries to present gARmenT at the **Albany Town Hall in August / September 2022.** 

gARmenT is a wearable art project aimed at bringing a diverse range of ages, cultures and makers together to build a creative community event, foster new community connections and grow the audience of the Albany Town Hall. This will involve local artists facilitating workshops with school groups, TAFE students and local community groups to contribute to the production of approximately 40 wearable art pieces.

gARmenT will be celebrated with a ticketed Gala Fashion Show and family friendly Matinee Show at the Albany Town Hall. The works will then be exhibited in the Town Hall for two weeks to showcase the project to the community as a whole.

The City of Albany's Arts and Culture are currently seeking expressions of interest from videographers who are keen to become the official videographer for this project. In addition to documenting the gARmenT events on August 27<sup>th</sup> and August 28th 2022, the videographer will be required to produce documentary behind the scenes footage at the dress rehearsal on August 26<sup>th</sup>, and of artists working in their studios or mentoring community groups during the development stages of the project.

A fee of \$4000 will be paid the Videographer \$100 an hour for 40 hours
